his pdf is something I made up to make it easier to tell people about the website. Once we've had a discussion and they show interest, and rather than trying to find something to write on, I just give them this card. It's no muss, no fuss, and I usually carry about 10 or 15 cards so I always have one to give out.

I tried to layout the card so that it will be very easy to work with. The file is ready to print just as it is. If you have a decent color printer then it should print just fine. If your printer does not give a satisfactory copy then do what I do, take the file to a quality copy shop to get a good color copy, although different printers or copiers can give a variety of color results. I use an 80 pound card stock to print on. It's close enough in stiffness to match a standard business card paper.

Now if this were printed in quantity and professionally then it would also be set up so the cards could be cut down to their individual size on a large paper cutter. However, because of the cost to have them cut down professionally, I set up the layout with dashed lines to ease the cutting by hand. I use a standard shop utility knife with a new sharp blade. I stand up over the work so I can press the straight edge firmly and cut slow holding the knife as vertical as possible.

My suggestion is first to cut the page in half using the dashed vertical center line. That way cutting along the horizontal and vertical lines will be easier.

So, if this card layout appeals to you, you're welcome to use it and enjoy it. And as usual...
